DAY 1 MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 8 NEW YORK CITY (Dinner)

Today, we will head to the airport for our flight to **New York City!** Upon arrival, we will meet our guide and coach to transfer us to our hotel for check-in. Our accommodations for the next four nights reside at the new **Hotel RIU Plaza Times Square**, located in the heart of Times Square. This hotel is close to everything! Dinner tonight is a short drive from the hotel at the famous **Carmine's**, a lively and fun Italian restaurant. It's the perfect way for everyone to get to know one another, and no one will leave hungry! After dinner we will head to **Top of the Rock** for admission to the 70th-floor, indoor/outdoor observation deck above Rockefeller Center.

DAY 2 TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9 NEW YORK CITY (Breakfast, Dinner)

Following breakfast at the hotel, we'll board the ferry to the **Statue of Liberty** and **Ellis Island**, two of the most famous symbols of American freedom. Take in the up-close views of the Lady in the Harbor from the ferry and then explore Ellis Island to discover the moving stories of the many immigrants who came here to pursue a better life. We will also have time at the **National 9/11 Memorial** for reflection. Our guide will lead us around the area, describing the renaissance of the area from before, during, and after 9/11. We'll then visit the **National 9/11 Museum**, which is a moving and powerful testament to survival and rebirth. Then we'll take a short stroll to **St. Paul's Cathedral** which miraculously survived the September 11th attacks and served as a triage center and beacon of hope for the first responders. Next up are **Wall Street**, the **New York Stock Exchange**, and the famous **Charging Bull!** After a wonderful dinner at a local restaurant, we'll **embark on an exclusive double-decker bus tour**, where we'll be treated to a captivating journey through the city's iconic landmarks. The tour includes stops at Times Square, Grand Central Station, Broadway, Chinatown, the Brooklyn Bridge, and more! Our journey will be accompanied by lively performers who will not only narrate the tour but also share intriguing tidbits about New York City.

DAY 3 WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10 NEW YORK CITY (Breakfast)

Enjoy breakfast before we start the day with a visit to the **Intrepid Air, Sea, and Space Museum**, an immersive journey through American military and maritime history boasting an impressive array of aircraft, spacecraft, and educational exhibits. Then it's time for **The High Line**, a public park built on a historic freight rail elevated above the streets on Manhattan's West Side. Saved from demolition by neighborhood residents and the city, The High Line opened in 2009 as a hybrid public space where visitors experience nature, art, and design. Following this, we'll venture into **Central Park**, the quintessential New Yorker's playground spanning 843 acres and the iconic backdrop in countless films, TV shows, books, and songs. Here, we'll pause to pay homage at Strawberry Field, a memorial to John Lennon featuring the iconic "Imagine" mosaic. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

DAY 4 THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 11 NEW YORK CITY (Breakfast, Dinner)

Our final full day begins with breakfast and a visit to the iconic **Plaza at Rockefeller Center**, where vibrant flags from around the world flutter amidst towering Art Deco skyscrapers, offering a glimpse into the city's rich history and captivating public artwork. Then, a **backstage tour awaits us at Radio City Music Hall**. This iconic theater has a long, rich history and beautiful architecture, and we will get to meet a Rockette! This afternoon, we will wander along Fifth Avenue, making a stop at the stunning **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, a Neo-Gothic-style Catholic Church in the heart of Manhattan. Next up is a visit to **Grand Central Terminal**, where the celestial ceiling and Beaux-Arts architecture enchant us before we marvel at the towering elegance of the **Chrysler Building**, a pinnacle of Art Deco design that graces the skyline. We'll cap off our day with a delicious farewell dinner at **Havana Central**, before culminating our journey with a **Broadway show**, a perfect ending to our unforgettable exploration of the Big Apple!

DAY 5 FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 12 HOME (Breakfast)

We will transfer to the airport following breakfast for our flight home.

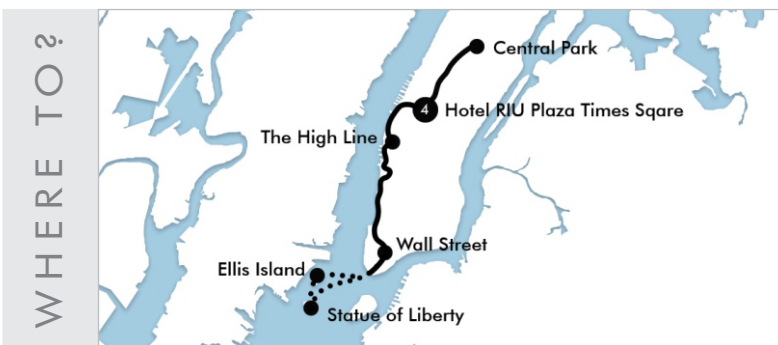
